Mural Dedication: The Baldwin Locomotive Mural dedication ceremony is scheduled for Thursday 11/14 at 6 PM. The artist, Phillip Adams, will be present.

Rat Problem: Joe Walsh reported that we are winning the war against rats in the park. In the three weeks prior to the meeting, no live rats were spotted. Also, no dead rats were found in the ten days prior to the meeting. Posters created by Suzanne Cross warning not to feed the wildlife and not to dispose of household trash were hung on the trash cans.

Treasurer's Report: Joan Markoe reported a total of \$15,883.21 in the account. There was a deposit of \$243.60 from membership dues. Expenses totaled \$219.46 for posters for Howl-O-Ween and rat posters. There are 64 household memberships, of which 38 are new members. As of the meeting, we had not received any money from the 2019 Parks on Tap.

Howl-O-Ween Dog Parade: This occurred on Saturday 10/26/19 and was a "howling" success with approximately 75 dogs and 150 people attending. Suggestions for next year's event include having a sign pointing to the photo site and posting a sign at the photo site identifying the park. To get a count of attendees, Peg suggested distributing stickers. Photos of the dogs were posted on the park's website.
