Howl-O-Ween Dog Costume Event: This event was a success with participation of 82 dogs and their owners. Estimates run as high 300 attendees for this event. Co-chairs Grace Hanrahan and Jan Roberts thanked those who contributed to the event's success especially: Nancy Van Arkel, Sherry Claypool, Sandy Owens, Jim Fennell, Stan Ordo, and Suzanne Cross. Next year, Jan Roberts will take over as the primary contact for this event.

Park Maintenance: On the 18th Street side of the park, the city plans to replace part of the fence over the cantilevered section over the Callowhill cut. There was a discussion of possibly replanting of some of the perennial beds. On the 19th Street side of the park the solar powered holiday lights on the pitch pine tree will be replaced by Stan Ordo. Also, we plan to replace the plastic trash can liners as the rats have chewed through the bottom of the plastic to get to discarded food. We will replace the 14 plastic trash cans with metal cans at a cost of about \$45 each.
